A Clinical Report published in the December, 1988 issue (Kraenzler EJ, Starr NJ: Heparin-associated thrombocytopenia: Management of patients for open heart surgery. Case reports describing the use of Iloprost. *ANESTHESIOLOGY* 69:964–967, 1988) should include two additional authors: Michael L. Miller, D.O. and William A. Schiavone, D.O.

In the May, 1990 issue of *ANESTHESIOLOGY*, a Letter to the Editor (Prasad KK, Chen L: Complications related to the use of a heat and moisture exchanger (letter). *ANESTHESIOLOGY* 72:958, 1990) contained an error: Mallinckrodt® was misspelled, both in the text and in the legend for the figure.

In a Letter to the Editor published in the May, 1990 issue of *ANESTHESIOLOGY* (Kubota Y, Toyoda Y, Kubota H: Blind selective bronchial catheterization. *ANESTHESIOLOGY* 72:955–956, 1990), on page 955, column two, the second sentence should read, "The most important factor determining final location of a catheter during blind selective bronchial catheterization is the guide mark which facilitates directing the catheter when the endotracheal tube is properly placed."

In a Clinical Investigation published in the June, 1990 issue of *ANESTHESIOLOGY* (Ferrari LR, Bedford RF: General anesthesia prior to treatment of anterior mediastinal masses in pediatric cancer patients. *ANESTHESIOLOGY* 72:991–995, 1990), on page 992, the heading of column two of table 1 should read "Patients."
