Of the 105 skeletons listed within the 6th revision of the ITSD, there are 30 complete and 5 incomplete wired mounts, and 51 complete and 19 incomplete loose boxed skeletons [Table 6]. The remainder of the skeletal material [74 specimens] is comprised of individual loose bones or parts thereof.
