Ferdinand Perret has here published separately the bibliography and index of his recently completed "Encyclopaedia of Spanish Colonial Art." The bibliography consists of 175 items divided geographically. Some are accompanied by brief descriptions of contents but none are annotated critically. This list of publications is obviously too brief to be very useful as a reference work. The lists of artists included

in the index, however, contain hundreds of names and are the most complete listings of this nature now available.

The author, born in Alsace in 1888, lives in Los Angeles, where he founded the Ferdinand Perret Research Library of the Arts and Their Affiliated Sciences. This was given to the National Collection of Fine Arts in Washington in 1949.
