The current issue of *History of Political Economy* presents a selection of papers from the conference titled “The History of Macroeconometric Modeling,” held in Utrecht, the Netherlands on April 6–7, 2017. It is the first of what we intend to be a series of annual special issues. To accommodate this new feature, each volume of the journal will henceforth comprise five regular issues each year, in addition to the supplement based on the annual *HOPE* conference.
