Robert H. Williams, M.D., of Seattle, will present the Banting Memorial Lecture on Saturday, June 25, and will receive the Banting Medal. Dr. Williams is Professor of Medicine and Head of the Division of Endocrinology at University Hospital, University of Washington.

- The 1966 Lilly Award will be presented to Norbert Freinkel, M.D., for the contribution he has made to our understanding of insulin homeostasis during pregnancy and of "alcohol hypoglycemia." Dr. Freinkel is Kettering Professor of Medicine and Chief of the Section of Endocrinology and Metabolism, Northwestern University, Chicago. He was formerly Director of the Diabetes and Metabolism Division, Thorndike Memorial Laboratory, Boston City Hospital, and Assistant Professor of Medicine, Harvard Medical School.
