AUDITOR'S STATEMENT

The accounts of the Treasurer have been examined by the undersigned duly appointed audit committee, with the following results:

The records of receipts from all sources were found to agree with the statements of deposits in the bank; and cancelled checks were found to be in accord with the record of disbursements. All receipts and disbursements are properly listed and balanced in the cash book. The Treasurer's Annual Report was checked in detail and found to be correct.

Two bank accounts are kept at the American Security and Trust Company—a checking account, and a savings account bearing 3% interest. Both balances were checked and found to be correct as of October 31, 1929, that of the checking account amounting to \$943.54, and that of the savings account to \$1221.85. This latter figure represents the total of uninvested balances of the four Funds itemized in Section B of the Treasurer's report.

The securities representing the investment of the Society's Life Membership Fund and the Meisinger Aerological Research Fund, consisting respectively of eleven \$100 bonds and one \$1000 bond, and an indenture of Trust covering the placing of the American Meteorological Society's Endowment Fund of \$2000, were examined. All bond coupons not due were found attached.

The commendation elicited from previous auditors concerning this Treasurer's conduct of his office is most heartily reiterated by this committee.
