A native of Breckenridge, Minnesota, Christensen earned an A.S. from North Dakota State School of Science in 1975, his B.S. in Pharmacy in 1978 at North Dakota State University and his PharmD in 1982 at the University of Tennessee. He completed residency training in pediatrics at Le Bonheur Children's Medical Center in Memphis, and his fellowship in pharmacokinetics and pharmacodynamics was at St. Jude Children's Research Hospital. Dr. Christensen spent six years at St. Jude

as a clinical pharmacist and developed the hospital's nutrition support service. He was board certified in nutrition support in 1993. He joined the UT College of Pharmacy full time in 1990, where he now is professor of clinical pharmacy and also holds an appointment in the College of Medicine as professor of pediatrics. From 1994 to 2003, he was the co-director of the Pediatric Pharmacology Research Unit funded by the National Institutes of Health. Dr. Christensen has published more than 130 articles, book chapters, and abstracts. His collaborative research program has received more than \$4 million in funding over the past decade.
