ALLIED HEALTH POSTGRADUATE COURSE HIGHLY SUCCESSFUL

Attendance at the Second Allied Health Postgraduate Course in Diabetes, held in Minneapolis April 20-22, totaled 145. Registrants included fifty-four nurses, seventy-six dietitians and nutritionists, and seven physicians. The balance comprised two health educators, an occupational therapist, a registered pharmacist, a medical x-ray technician, and so forth. The Course, principally directed to nurses, dietitians, and nutritionists, was presented under the auspices of the Committee on Professional Education of the American Diabetes Association. The program was developed by Donnell D. Etwiler, M.D., Director of the Course, in cooperation with the Diabetes Detection and Education Center in Minneapolis.
