The following products are being recalled because they may contain high levels of lead, which is toxic if ingested by young children and can cause adverse health effects.

Halloween mini-figurines

Units: About 14,000

Importer: Coyne's & Company Inc., of Minneapolis

Description: The recalled Casper the Friendly Ghost mini-figurines are made of resin and paper. They were sold in mini bags decorated with a spider and web design. The figurines are dressed as Dracula, skeleton, devil, mummy, Casper and Wendy the Witch. The figurines are stamped with TM & Harvey Ent. Coyne's & Company and CP1030 are printed on a white sticker on the bottom of the bags.
