The U.S. Consumer Product Safety Commission (CPSC) has announced recalls of the following products. Consumers should stop using recalled products unless otherwise instructed. For a complete list of recalled products, visit www.cpsc.gov.

Crib toys

Units: 15,000

Manufacturer: Kids II Inc., of Alpharetta, Ga.

Hazard: The anchors that hold the straps to the back of the turtle can detach, posing a choking hazard to young children.

Description: The Baby Einstein Baby Neptune Soothing Seascape crib toy is a plastic molded turtle with a toy aquarium body that has fabric straps that attach to the side rails of a crib. Model number 30858 is printed on the label. Only crib toys manufactured in October 2007 with date code BJ7 printed on the back of the battery compartment are recalled.

Sold at: Discount department stores and online retailers nationwide from November 2007 through January 2008 for \$25 to \$30.
