The U.S. Consumer Product Safety Commission (CPSC) has announced recalls of the following products. Consumers should stop using recalled products unless otherwise instructed. For a complete list of recalled products, visit www.cpsc.gov.

Stuffed toys

Units: About 35,000 in the United States and 5,400 in Canada

Importer: Old Navy LLC, of San Francisco

Hazard: The toys have plastic button eyes that can detach, posing a choking hazard.

Description: The toys are made of cotton and come in a variety of styles: brown plaid creature (style no. 612756), pink striped dove (600571), gray dog (600572), hot pink creature (612800), white dog (612738), brown penguin (612672), light pink rabbit (612671), brown reindeer (612728) and dark pink rabbit (612806). The style number is on a white label sewn into the side seam of the toy.

Sold at: Old Navy stores and online at www.oldnavy.com from July 2008 through February 2009 for \$6 to \$10.
