Jackets with drawstrings

Units: About 210,000

Manufacturer/Importer: GTM Sportswear Inc., of Manhattan, Kan.

Hazard: Drawstrings through the hood of the jacket can pose a strangulation hazard to children.

Description: This recall involves GTM Sportswear brand children's hooded nylon jackets in sizes XXS-XL (2T-16) and in various colors. Affected styles include Youth Medalist Jacket (YJA180), Youth Legacy Jacket (YJAPT01), Youth Eclipse Jacket (YLJA186), Youth Dominator Jacket (YJA3800), Youth Booster Jacket (YJA150) and Youth Achiever Jacket (YJA161).
