The U.S. Consumer Product Safety Commission (CPSC) has announced the recall of the following products. Consumers should stop using recalled products unless otherwise instructed. Children's task lamps

Units: 13,000

Importer: Target Corp., of Minneapolis

Hazard: Lamps may overheat, causing the adhesive inside the lamp socket to melt and move into the bulb area of the socket.

Description: Four styles are recalled: striped with navy-colored head, sky blue and white stripes and blue lamp base (UPC 490970221923); sports with white head, baseball stitch pattern and blue lamp base (UPC 490970222685); dot with white head, lines of multicolored dots and lavender lamp base (UPC 490970224047); and flower dot with pink head, pattern of white flowers and leaves and pink lamp base (UPC 490970221947).

Sold at: Target stores and Target.com from January through April 2011 for about \$13.

Remedy: Return to store for refund.
