Units: About 500

Importer: Reiss Innovations LLC, of Manchester, Conn.

Hazard: When two or more magnets are swallowed, they can link together inside a child's intestines and clamp onto body tissues, causing blockages or holes in the intestines, infection and death.

Description: High-powered magnet sets sold under the DynoCube.com brand name for use as a novelty item or desk toy contain 216 small, silver, spherical magnets.

Sold exclusively at: amazon.com/dynocube.com from July 2011 through April 2012 for about \$20.
