

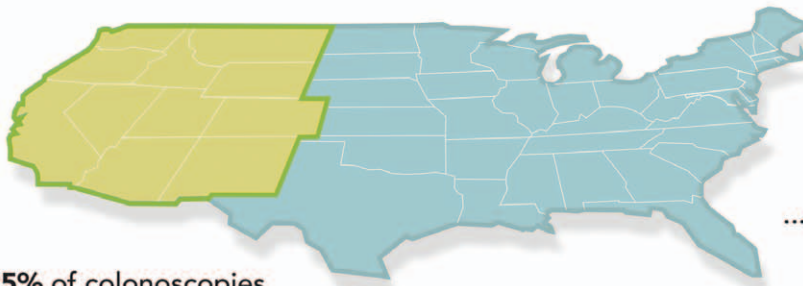

In the West, **82%** of anesthesiologists spend **<10%** of their time supervising non-physicians...

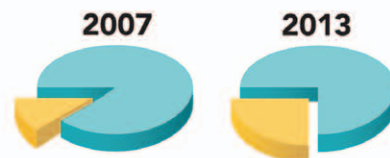
...compared to the rest of the country, where **1/3** spend **70% or more** time supervising.



...compared to **55%** in the Northeast.

25% of colonoscopies in the West are performed with anesthesia providers...

Female anesthesiologists are now **25%** of the workforce, up from **22%**.
