Baby food pouch topper

Units: About 6,000

Hazard: The tube of the pouch topper that screws onto the food pouch can separate from the round base, posing a choking hazard to young children.

Description: PouchPops are silicone toppers that screw onto a baby food pouch that allow infants to feed themselves. Sold in a four-pack (green, orange, red and yellow), they have a cylinder-shaped tube stem that attaches to a round base. A "SipP" logo and smiley face are on the circular base.
