DIABETES MEETING IN PITTSBURGH

MEETING IN MARSEILLES

The Fourth International Meeting of Endocrinology of Marseilles, entitled "The Regulation of the Adipose Tissue Mass," will be held in Marseilles, France, July 10-13, 1973, immediately preceding the Eighth Congress of the International Diabetes Federation to be held in Brussels, July 15-20. The program, under the chairmanship of Professor Jean Vague, will include biochemical aspects, morphology and metabolism of adipose cells, adipose mass and composition of the human body, endogenous and exogenous factors of regulation, and adipose tissue and health.
