Diabetes Week this year will be November 12-18, following the usual practice of observing Diabetes Week the week before Thanksgiving. Affiliate Associations and Committees on Diabetes of County and State Medical Societies are urged to note this date in making plans for their Public Education and Detection programs.

NEWS OF AFFILIATE ASSOCIATIONS

The DIABETES ASSOCIATION OF GREATER CHICAGO will hold its Fifteenth Annual Symposium on Diabetes Mellitus at the Holiday Inn, One South Halsted Street, Chicago, Illinois, on Friday, November 17. "Diabetic Complications—Recent Developments" will be the theme of the symposium. The Sixteenth Rollin Turner Woodyatt Memorial Lecture will be delivered by Stefan S. Fajans, M.D., Ann Arbor, Immediate

Past President of the American Diabetes Association, who will be introduced by Arthur R. Colwell, Sr., M.D., Chicago, also a Past President. Dr. Fajans' topic will be "Basement Membrane Thickening in Diabetes Mellitus: Critical Review and Findings in Latent Diabetes."

Other speakers and their subjects will be: Albert I. Winegrad, M.D., Philadelphia, "The Polyol Pathway and the Complications of Diabetes"; Sheldon Berger, M.D., Chicago, "Hyperosmolar Nonketotic Coma"; Frederick C. Goetz, M.D., Minneapolis, "Experiences with Organ Transplantation in Human Diabetes Mellitus."

A series of workshops will also be held to provide an opportunity for those in attendance to discuss special problems or questions about diabetes.

Enrollment is free for members of the Diabetes Association of Greater Chicago or the American Diabetes Association, and for medical students and resident house staff members and nurses. The fee for non-members is \$10.00. Dietitians who register will pay \$5.00, except for dietetic interns and dietetic trainees. Registration must be made in advance.

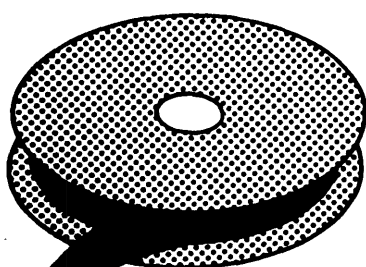
NEWS NOTES
