JUNE 23-24 IS THE DATE FOR THIRTY-THIRD ANNUAL MEETING

As previously announced, the Scientific Sessions of the Thirty-third Annual Meeting of the American Diabetes Association will be held at The Drake in Chicago, Illinois, Saturday and Sunday, June 23-24. The Central Council will meet on Thursday, June 21, and the Board of Directors Friday, June 22.

Arnold Lazarow, M.D., Ph.D., Minneapolis, will deliver the Banting Memorial Lecture, entitled "Selective Islet Differentiation in Organ Culture and Islet Transplantation," at the close of the Scientific Sessions on Saturday morning, June 23, and will receive a Banting Medal.

The 1973 Lilly Award will be presented to Arthur H. Rubenstein, M.D., Chicago, for his significant contributions to research concerned with circulating proinsulin and C-peptide. The Award is supported by Eli Lilly and Company and consists of \$1,000 and a medal. It is given to an investigator under the age of forty to recognize demonstrated research in

the field of diabetes, taking into consideration independence of thought and originality.

The program of the Annual Meeting will be published as a supplement to this Journal prior to the Meeting. The supplement also will include abstracts of papers to be presented and of those to be read By Title. It will be distributed without charge to Members of the Association and to subscribers to the Journal. Nonmembers who register at the Meeting will receive the Program as part of the registration fee of \$10.00. Others may purchase copies at \$2.00 each.
