In the print version of the article listed above, errors occurred in the numbering of reference citations. References 20, 21, 22, 23, and 24 should be references 19, 20, 21, 22, and 23, respectively. However, in the sentence “Second, because of the reciprocal influences between emotional distress and diabetes self-management, distress can indicate increased risk for poor treatment outcomes; interventions that focus on addressing both distress and diabetes management are likely to have stronger effects than those that focus on either in isolation (21)” reference 21 is correct. In addition, in the sentence “This is consistent with dominant theories on the functional implications of emotion, which argue that emotions, both positive and negative, serve to indicate how well a behavior is leading to a desired outcome or goal (25)” reference 25 should be reference 24. The online version reflects these changes.
