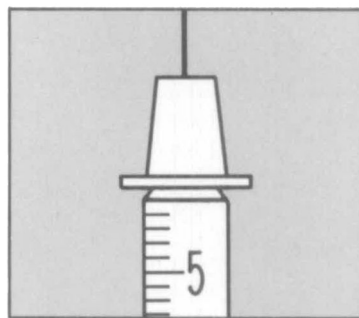
FOURTEENTH RESEARCH SYMPOSIUM

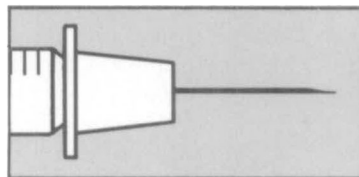

IX IDF CONGRESS

The Ninth Congress of the International Diabetes Federation will take place in New Delhi, India, October 31- November 5, 1976. There will be a plenary Session on the afternoon of Sunday, October 31. The Scientific Program will be built around five special lectures, 18 three-hour Panel symposia, nine three-hour workshops, and the usual Free Communication Sessions. There will be daily Poster Sessions and, on November 5, two Stop Press Sessions, for papers on significant work done since the selection of abstracts.
