NEW EXECUTIVE VICE-PRESIDENT

John L. Dugan, Jr., Short Hills, N.J., has been appointed Executive Vice President of the American Diabetes Association, effective February 1, 1977.

Mr. Dugan has been Special Consultant to the Treasurer and Director of Administrative Services of the Robert Wood Johnson Foundation in Princeton, New Jersey, since October 1975.

Previously, Mr. Dugan was Vice President, Finance and Administration, of the Chicopee Manufacturing Co. (industrial products division of Johnson & Johnson). Before that he was Treasurer of the Underwood Corporation of New York, Assistant to the President of the Grace National Bank of New York, and a Consultant with Booz, Allen & Hamilton, New York.

A graduate in Engineering of Swarthmore College in Pennsylvania, Mr. Dugan was awarded an M.B.A. in Industrial Management by the University of Pennsylvania in 1950. He has been an instructor at the Wharton School of the University of Pennsylvania, the American Institute of Banking, and Swarthmore College. He is an Adjunct Associate Professor of Management and Business Policy at St. Peter's College and Fairleigh Dickinson University in New Jersey.

He is President of the Alumni Association and a Board member of Swarthmore College and participates in a broad range of civic activities in Short Hills and Millburn Township, New Jersey, and Buck Hill Falls, Pennsylvania.

He served in the United States Navy for three-and-one-half years during World War II, rising in rank from Ensign to Lieutenant Commander.

CENTRAL COUNCIL TO MEET IN JUNE

The Central Council, the general voting body of the American Diabetes Association, will hold its Tenth Meeting on June 2-4, 1977, during the Association's Thirty-seventh Annual Meeting in St. Louis, Mo. The expanded schedule will permit Delegates to hear speeches and take part in discussions, workshops, and forums to learn about the major issues facing the Association. They will have a greater voice in the decisions that will determine the Association's future course.

Before the meeting the various Committees of the Association will meet to discuss matters they are charged with considering by the Board of Directors. Reports and recommendations will be sent to Central Council Delegates and key Affiliate officers and staff for study before the Central Council sessions.
