DIET AND EXERCISE

A symposium entitled "Diet and Exercise: Synergism in Health Maintenance" will be held on November 3-4, 1981 in Lake Buena Vista, Florida at the Walt Disney World Complex. The symposium will be sponsored by the Department of Foods and Nutrition of the American Medical Association in conjunction with the AMA's Council on Scientific Affairs and Council on Continuing Physician Education, and the Florida Medical Association.

The symposium will focus on the role of nutrition and exercise in the promotion of health and the treatment of major health problems. Emphasis will be placed on the physiologic effects of moderate habitual activity coupled with sound nutrition practices, i.e., the role of nutrition and exercise in health maintenance and in the treatment of some chronic degenerative disease states.

The AMA Council on Continuing Physician Education and the American Dietetic Association have approved the symposium for continuing medical education credits.

HORMONES AND CELL REGULATION

The Vth European Symposium on Hormones and Cell Regulation will be held on October 5-8, 1981 at Le Bischenberg, Bischoffsheim (near Strasbourg), France.
