ADA/NAASO JOINT CONFERENCE ON OBESITY AND NON-INSULIN-DEPENDENT DIABETES MELLITUS

A conference on Obesity and Non-Insulin-Dependent Diabetes Mellitus, presented by the Amer-

ican Diabetes Association and the North American Association for the Study of Obesity, will be held October 30–November 1, 1985 at the Inn on the Park Hotel in Toronto, Ontario.
