ADA/NAASO JOINT CONFERENCE ON OBESITY AND NON-INSULIN-DEPENDENT DIABETES MELLITUS

A research conference on Obesity and Non-Insulin-Dependent Diabetes Mellitus, presented by the American Diabetes Association and the North American Association for the Study of Obesity, will be held October 30–November 1, 1985 at the Inn on the Park Hotel in Toronto, Ontario. THIRD NATIONAL HEALTH AND NUTRITION EXAMINATION SURVEY (NHANES III)

The National Center for Health Statistics is soliciting suggestions for topics to be considered in the

planning process for the third National Health and Nutrition Examination Survey (NHANES III) to be fielded in 1988. As in previous NHANES programs, the primary purpose of NHANES III will be to measure and monitor the health and nutritional status of the U.S. population. In addition, consideration is being given to the establishment of a prospective cohort study using NHANES III as the baseline. It is anticipated that a three-hour examination consisting of questionnaires, biochemical measurements, and medical procedures will be administered to approximately 20,000 persons ages 6 months to 74 years over a two-year period.
