

data seems to favor relatively shallow water deposition for most of the marine rocks in the Council Grove Group, but whether the water reached maximum depths of 10, 30, 60, or 100 feet is open to question . . . ”

### Future Plans

One exciting possibility yet ahead of us is a field excursion following either the Kansas Turnpike, Interstate Highway 70 and U.S. Highway 40, or one of several other shorter routes using road logs from the Kansas State Geological Survey published by Merriam (1963). These logs gave name and location of various outcroppings exposed along roadcuts. Such logs, along with a generalized column of Kansas rocks (fig. 5), provide an opportunity to observe successive strata separately. Such a trip would require one day or more but would encompass millions of years in geologic time.

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## Student Science Training Projects

NSF-supported science projects will involve 3,400 top high school students in scientific research and study programs this summer. The projects, covering a wide spectrum of the biological, physical and social sciences, technology, and mathematics, are designed to offer guidance and encouragement to young people with strong potentials for scientific and technical careers. Selection of high school students to participate is based on scholastic ability, scientific motivation, and the completion of specified courses in science and mathematics. Students are selected primarily from those now in the 11th grade. Students are expected to pay their own expenses for room, board, travel, and in some cases tuition; however, limited funds are available to support students who would otherwise be unable to attend.
