IVTH INTERNATIONAL SYMPOSIUM ON COMPARATIVE LEUKEMIA RESEARCH

The IVth International Symposium on Comparative Leukemia Research will be held in the U.S.A. at the Cherry Hill Inn, Cherry Hill, New Jersey, from September 21–25, 1969.

The Symposium will take place under the auspices of the World Committee for Comparative Leukemia Research and the World Health Organization. During the four day meeting, seven scientific sessions will be held covering etiology, epidemiology, pathogenesis, detection, control and prevention of leukemia in animals and in man.

A \$45.00 registration fee will be charged for all active members of the Symposium. Accompanying members (family) will be required to pay a \$30.000 registration fee per person.

All participants and attendees will be accommodated at the Cherry Hill Inn at a special rate for the Symposium period (single occupancy—\$98.00, double occupancy—\$77.00 per person). This “package plan” will include lodging from Sunday night through Thursday night, all breakfasts, coffees, luncheons, one dinner, two receptions, and the final banquet.

The Organization Committee wishes to encourage all from Europe who plan to attend the Symposium to take advantage of the special jet charter flight which will leave London on September 21 for Philadelphia, returning 14 days later. Round trip fare for the charter flight will be \$175.00. A deposit of \$50.00 must be received by no later than 15 April, 1969, in order to insure a seat on the flight. The remaining \$125.00 must be received no later than 1 July, 1969. All checks or money orders must be in American denominations.

The AAA International Travel Service of Cherry Hill, New Jersey, will serve as the official travel agency for the International Symposium. All checks for the Charter Flight should be made out to: *AAA International Travel Agency*, and mailed directly to:
