

ERRATUM: Sustained out-of-sequence shortening along a tectonically active segment of the Main Boundary thrust: The Dhauladhar Range in the northwestern Himalaya

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When this article was originally published, the word “shorting” was inadvertently substituted for “shortening” five times. Shortening was the word that should have appeared throughout the paper. The corrections follow:

Abstract, paragraph 2, line 10 should read: shortening by out-of-sequence faulting. Assuming that present-day geodetic shortening rates ($\sim 14 \pm 2 \text{ mm a}^{-1}$) across the northwest Himalaya

Page 717, left column, 2nd paragraph, line 27 should read: strain the spatial distribution of crustal shortening

Page 723, right column, lines 4–5 up from the bottom should read: mm a^{-1} of crustal shortening over the past 10 m.y. Assuming that present-day geodetic shortening
