

Two New ASME Journals Announced Journal of Basic Engineering to be Discontinued

ASME announces the closing of its JOURNAL OF BASIC ENGINEERING. The last publication date of this *Journal* will be this December issue.

Starting in 1973, the papers which had appeared regularly in the JOURNAL OF BASIC ENGINEERING will now be published in two new ASME Quarterly *Journals*—the *Journal of Fluids Engineering* and the *Journal of Engineering Materials and Technology*.

The *Journal of Fluids Engineering* will publish papers on: fluid mechanics engineering, the design of fluid machines and fluid transients, fluid mechanics of medicine and human biology, power fluidic controls, multiphase and cavitating flows, and fluid systems. The *Journal of Fluids Engineering* will be published in March, June, September, and December.

The *Journal of Engineering Materials and Technology* will publish papers on: biomedical materials ceramics, composites, constitutive behavior, design codes, effects of fabrication procedures, environmental effects, failure analysis, fracture mechanics, friction and wear, interpretation of data, lifetime production, mechanical metallurgy, metalforming analysis, metals and alloys, performance of engineering materials, rubber and plastics, structure/property relationships, and test procedures. The *Journal* will be published in January, April, July, and October.

ASME members now subscribing to the JOURNAL OF BASIC ENGINEERING (October 1972–September 1973) will automatically receive the first three issues of both new *Journals* and of course the final issue of the JOURNAL OF BASIC ENGINEERING.
