

RANKING 4:

Expected GDP Growth to 2020



RANKING 4 shows the ranking for total GDP growth. To calculate this ranking we add the projected rate of population growth estimated by the United Nations to the expected growth in GDP per capita of Ranking 3.

The top country in this ranking is India, driven to that position because of its high growth in GDP per capita we expect from Ranking 3. The remaining 9 countries in the top 10 are all in Sub-Saharan Africa, buoyed by their high projected population growth. This can be seen by the difference in their rankings in total GDP growth and in GDP growth per capita (in parenthesis). In order from 2nd to 10th they are Malawi (22), Tanzania (26), Liberia (9), Kenya (13), Uganda (34), Madagascar (35), Zimbabwe (24), Mali (54) and Zambia (64). *Map 4* shows the geographic pattern of total GDP growth. It shows the concentration of growth in East Africa, India, Pakistan, China and other East Asian countries, Mexico, Turkey and Egypt. *Figure 4* plots total GDP growth as a function of GDP per capita.

BY REGION:

By region, in East Asia and the Pacific the expected leaders in GDP growth are Philippines (13), Vietnam (14) and China (15), while the laggard is Australia (123). In South Asia the

best performing country is expected to be India (1), while Sri Lanka is the laggard (64). In Eastern Europe and Central Asia the top performers are Turkey (20), Kyrgyz Republic (25) and Uzbekistan (32). The worst performers in this region are Kazakhstan (116) and Azerbaijan (120).

In Latin America the fastest growing countries are expected to be Guatemala (17), Mexico (24) and Panama (29) while very poor performance is expected in Cuba (122), Venezuela (125) and Trinidad and Tobago (127). Egypt (11), Jordan (21) and Syria (27) are expected to lead GDP growth in the Middle East and North Africa, while the laggards are Qatar (121) and Libya (126).

While countries in Sub-Saharan Africa are in 9 of the 10 top spots for total GDP growth, the worst performers in the region, namely Mauritius (110), Gabon (118) and Angola (119), are among the worst in the world. While Gabon and Angola are affected by their reliance on oil, Mauritius is impacted by its high level of income relative to its ECI and COI and by its low expected population growth.

GDP growth in Western Europe is expected to be lead by The United Kingdom (47), followed by Finland (65). At the bottom of the list we expect to find Norway (124) and Germany (128). ●

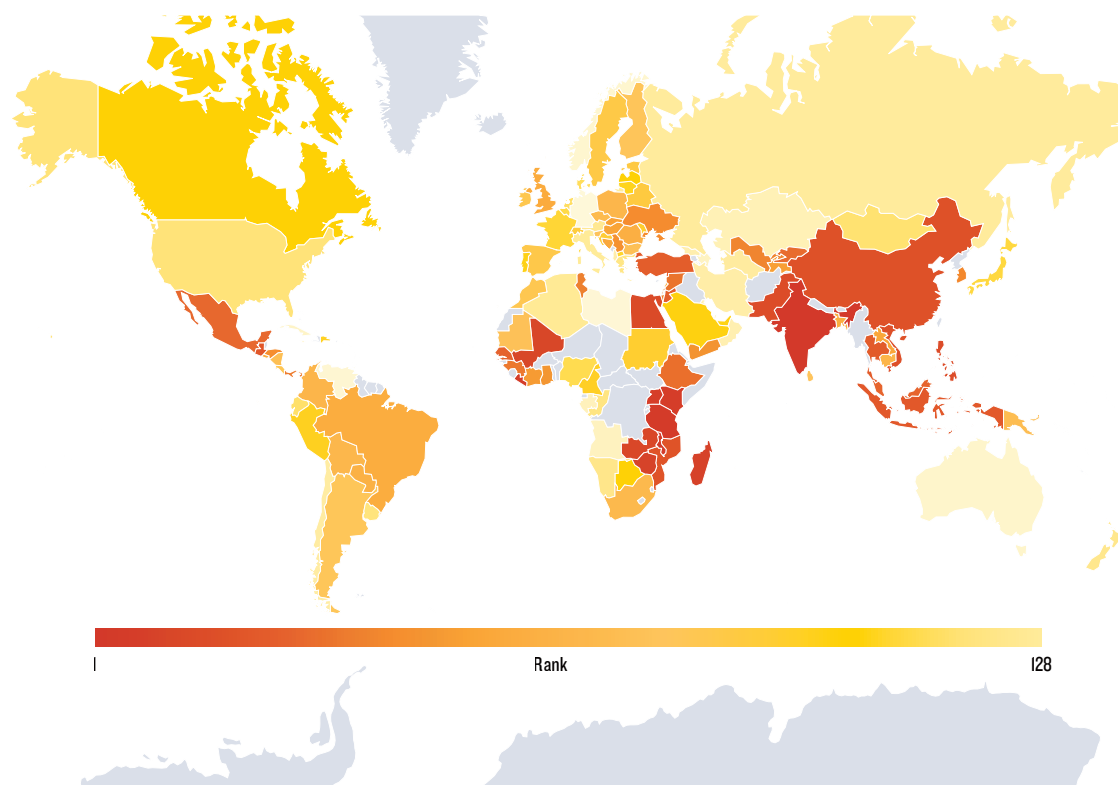
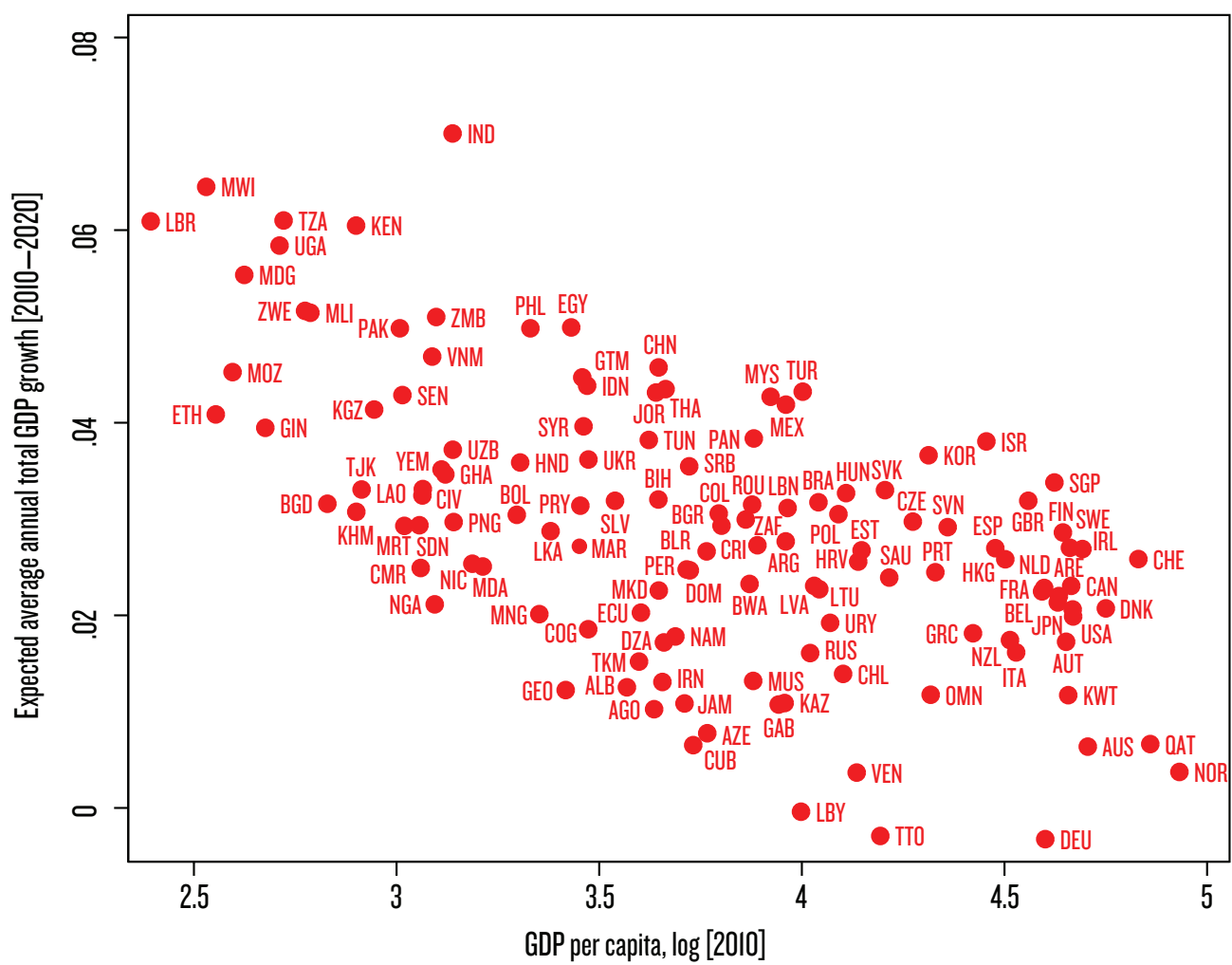
