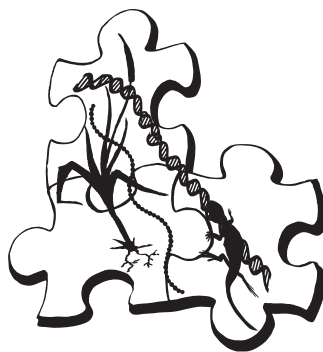


THE ABT BIOMYSTERY
