### AMERICAN JOURNAL OF THERAPEUTICS AND CLINICAL REPORTS

Volume 1 of a new quarterly journal, *American Journal of Therapeutics and Clinical Reports*, will appear in 1975. This new journal is designed to meet the need of physicians, researchers, pharmacologists, and clinicians for access to the case work of their counterparts all over the country. Focusing on the interrelated fields of medicine, pathology, pharmacology, and therapeutics, the journal will publish reports concerned with established drugs used in the usual manner, for new indications, or in new ways; and investigational drugs tested in Phases I, II, and III of clinical trials but particularly in Phase I.

Because the journal is intended to serve as a central repository for case reports, it is committed to high academic standards of documentation. Wherever possible, the journal's format will include pertinent editorial commentary on each case report by one or more members of the editorial board. Reports covering not only a single case but several cases will also be considered for publication, where two or three cases supplement and complement each other.

## Erratum

The following corrections should be made in the paper, entitled "Pharmacological and Therapeutic Efficacy of Daunomycin:DNA Complex in Mice," by Takao Ohnuma, James F. Holland, and Jeng-Hsien Chen, published in the July 1975 issue of *CANCER RESEARCH*. In the Summary, page 1767, Line 14, "The complex was cleared for plasma . . ." should be changed to "The complex was cleared from plasma . . ." On page 1770, Table 2, Column 1, Line 7 of Part B, "L1210, 10<sup>4</sup> i.p." should read "L1210, 10<sup>5</sup> i.p." In Table 2, Line 3 of Part C, the values in Columns 6 through 8, "13.5," "-3.5," and "0/10," which presently refer to "1.0, Days 1-5" under "Dose (mg/kg)" should instead refer to "3.0, Days 1-5" under "Dose (mg/kg)."
