FELLOWSHIP IN MEDICAL ONCOLOGY

Applications are being accepted from candidates who are interested in a Joint Collaborative Training Program in Medical Oncology involving major teaching hospitals of Brown University's Program in Medicine, beginning July 1976 and July 1977. This program offers clinical and research activities in clinical pharmacology and cancer chemotherapy, biochemical pharmacology, drug development, and tumor immunology, and participates in national cooperative chemotherapy groups to aid in the management of patients with solid tumors and hematological malignancies seen at many of the hospitals in the Providence area. Prerequisites include 2 years of approved Medical Residency and A.B.I.M. eligibility. Candidates with academic interests are encouraged to apply.
