### INTERNATIONAL SYMPOSIUM ON NEW TRENDS IN HUMAN IMMUNOLOGY AND CANCER IMMUNOTHERAPY

An international symposium on new trends in human immunology and cancer immunotherapy will be held in Montpellier, France, January 17 to 19, 1980. Topics will include: phenotype and functions of human lymphocyte subpopulations; characterization and role of the Fc receptor; human lymphoblastoid cell lines as models of differentiation; immune status of cancer patients; and immunotherapy in human cancer. ### E.O.R.T.C. SYMPOSIUM ON THE IMMUNOPHARMACOLOGICAL EFFECTS OF RADIOTHERAPY

An E.O.R.T.C. symposium on the immunopharmacological effects of radiotherapy will be held in Montpellier, France, March 13 to 15, 1980. The program will include invited and proffered papers on the following topics: clinical and experimental aspects of the effects of ionizing radiation on the immune response; immediate, secondary, and long-term effects of radiotherapy on the immune response and on the host-tumor relationship in cancer patients; correction or modulation of the changes induced by radiotherapy; and therapeutical associations between radiotherapy and immunotherapy and between radiotherapy and chemotherapy.
