### SEVENTY-NINTH ANNUAL MEETING OF THE AMERICAN ASSOCIATION FOR CANCER RESEARCH, INC.

The scientific sessions of the 79th Annual Meeting of the American Association for Cancer Research (AACR), Inc., will be held at the New Orleans Convention Center, New Orleans, Louisiana, from 8 a.m., Wednesday, May 25, 1988, until midday on Saturday, May 28, 1988.
