Erratum

Tsai, P. W. Nichols, T. Horn, G. G. Hermann, K. Steven, R. K. Ross, M. C. Yu, and P. A. Jones, which appeared in the March 1, 1993 issue of *Cancer Research* (pp. 1162–1166), contains an error in Table 2 under the “Base change” heading. The base change for patient B31 next to codon 287 incorrectly read GAG→ACA. It should have read GAG→GAA.
