Correction

In the paper by Y. Chen *et al.*, which appeared in the July 15, 1996 issue of *Cancer Research* (pp. 3168–3172), we recently discovered three minor errors: (a) in the Kinase Assay section of "Materials and Methods," the kinase buffer was given at 5× concentration. The correct 1× concentration is 15 mM HEPES (pH 7.5), 20 mM MgCl₂, 5 mM EGTA, 0.6 mM DTT, and 0.2 mg/ml BSA; (b) in Fig. 1B, the lanes were labeled incorrectly. The lanes should read, from left to right; *Lane 1*, preimmune; *Lane 2*, anti-BRCA1N; *Lane 3*, IP/IP; *Lane 4*, anti-BRCA1Bg1; *Lane 5*, IP/IP; *Lane 6*, Anti-BRCA1; and *Lane 7*, IP/IP; and (c) in the legend to Fig. 4, the cell extracts used in the kinase assay were from T24 bladder carcinoma cells and not HBL100 cells, as described. These are minor errors that in no way alter the conclusions of our paper.
