In Table 3 of the article cited above, the β (95% CI) and *P* value data were incorrect due to a calculation error. The revised data do not identify specific associations of measures of autonomic function with fasting measures of insulin resistance or insulin secretion available in the Cardiovascular Health Study (CHS). However, the main outcome of the article—that certain measures of cardiac autonomic function are prospectively associated with fasting glucose level changes—remains unaffected.
