## Philip H. Jones Award

A student award is given at each regional symposium for the best oral presentation. This award was created as a memorial to the late Philip H. Jones, who was a founding and long-standing member of the CAWQ. It includes a cash prize of \$200 at the closing ceremony of the symposium; a one-year membership in the CAWQ, including a subscription to the *Water Quality Research Journal of Canada*; the publication of the name of the winning student in an issue of the journal and on the CAWQ Web site; a certificate acknowledging his/her performance; and a formal invitation from the CAWQ president to submit his/her work for peer review and eventual publication in the *Water Quality Research Journal of Canada*.

For the 5th Western Canadian Symposium on Water Quality Research held in Whistler, B.C., on May 4, 2004, the Philip H. Jones student award winner was
