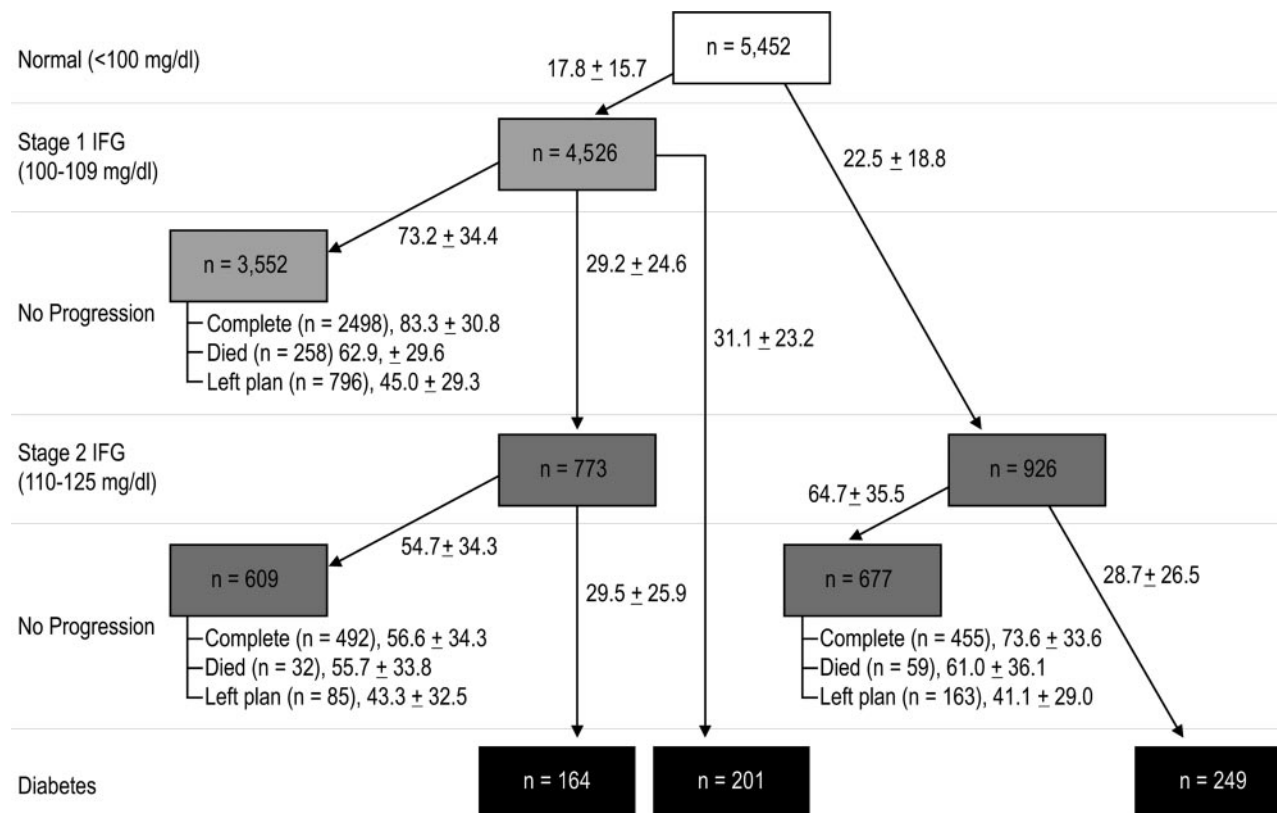


# Erratum

Nichols GA, Hillier TA, Brown JB: Progression from newly acquired impaired fasting glucose to type 2 diabetes. *Diabetes Care* 30:228–233, 2007

In the article listed above, Fig. 1 was incorrectly drawn: the line extending from the normal box (<100 mg/dl;  $n = 5,452$ ) to the diabetes box ( $n = 201$ ) should have originated from the added IFG box (100–109 mg/dl;  $n = 4,526$ ). The corrected figure is shown below. All accompanying text in the manuscript is accurate as published.
